he Fundació Crèdit Andorrà was created more than 33 years ago with the mission of implementing specific programmes to improve the qualitative development of the economic, cultural and social life of the Principality of Andorra. As part of this mission, it is the job of the Foundation Board of Trustees to decide on the actions and objectives it should focus on at any given time according to the priorities and needs gleaned from the social, cultural and economic circumstances in the Principality.

Year after year, the Foundation seeks to fulfil its bylaws and provide the Andorran society with the tools to ensure everyone can enjoy favourable living conditions.

This goal was more than fulfilled in 2020, when the Fundació Crèdit Andorrà initially had to postpone all its face-to-face programmes due to the COVID-19 health crisis. However, the Foundation reacted quickly and managed to offer its users alternatives that provided the tools for a better quality of life.

L'espai, a social centre offering activities and educational opportunities for the over-60s and thereby working with a highly vulnerable group, had to close its doors, but the Fundació Crèdit Andorrà quickly launched the L'espai Aula Virtual Classroom to keep its users from being isolated and to continue offering entertainment and training. At the same time, starting in September, we worked to offer a live online training platform to redirect our popular classes on communication and information technologies and provide other workshops and talks which seek to foster holistic healthy ageing and language training.

The impact of the health crisis has been particularly hard on people in situations of vulnerability and on the 400 seasonal workers stranded in the country due to the closure of the borders. As a result, the Foundation was particularly sensitive to the needs of the Food Bank run by Càritas Andorrana, increasing its financial support and forging a new partnership with the charity shop opened by the Andorran Red Cross.

In terms of culture, the health crisis forced us to cancel all face-to-face activities scheduled for March as part of the 27th season of the Andorran National Classical Orchestra (ONCA) Foundation. Nevertheless, Foundation, of which the Fundació Crèdit Andorrà is a patron, promoted a full programme of music activities in solidarity with the Andorran society. offering musical gifts they could enjoy at home, in conjunction with people associated with the ONCA Foundation and many others who altruistically wanted to participate and contribute in whatever way they could.

Fortunately, the health pressures gradually eased and the faceto-face cultural activities were resumed in September, albeit with strict safety measures. This meant the ONCA Foundation could once again schedule concerts and the third Ordino Classic festival was held, which prove to be a resounding success. This year, it had an exclusively domestic line-up, showcasing the talent in our country and demonstrating that culture is safe and never stops.





The professionals of tomorrow

As part of its belief that educating and training people is an essential part of the social, economic and cultural progress of our country, the Fundació Privada Crèdit Andorrà has announced the annual call for applications for excellence grants, aimed at university students who wish to study for a master's degree abroad.

Postgraduate grant programme

Difficulties in university administrative procedures, caused by the health crisis; a lack of information on the how classes were to be organised; and students' uncertainty as to whether they would be able to travel to the country they had chosen for their studies led to a rush of applications, and we were unable to award any grants.



To date, over 200 young people have benefited from funding to study hospitality and tourism and take postgraduate courses in various fields, including Science, Health Sciences, Art and Humanities, Social Sciences and Law, Engineering and Architecture.

The Fundació Crèdit Andorrà continues to support the University of Andorra by funding training projects to make enrolment costs more affordable for students and professionals.

Refresher courses

Health and social care professionals who had started postgraduate modules on caring for people with cognitive impairment were able to continue their training in their last postgraduate year.

Course on the law, legislative framework and resource map of Andorra (module 6)

This course examined the legislative framework in Andorra and existing and potential resources related to caring for and supporting individuals with cognitive impairment and their families. It also provided reflection on planning changes for improvement in current organisations.

The Fundació Crèdit Andorrà funded 50% of the fees for the postgraduate course.





- Health tips for people who live alone, guidelines on assertive communication, empathy and active listening, psychological management in quarantines, and others.

- > Workshops with video tutorials on creating musical instruments (in conjunction with the ONCA Foundation and La Moixera).
- > Workshops with video tutorials organised by members of the Association for Older Volunteers (AVIM).
- > Therapeutic exercises to do at home or in the nursing home.
- > Healthy tips and recipes.

Nourishing hope

The health, economic and social crisis caused by COVID-19 has aggravated many families' economic situation. Consequently, the Fundació Crèdit Andorrà reinforced its support to different groups and associations with the goal of helping to meet people's needs.

Food Bank

The Fundació Crèdit Andorrà, which has been working with the Càritas Andorrana Food Bank since 2011, expanded its financial support for the organisation. This assistance first involved providing vouchers for monthly purchases of fresh goods at supermarkets, followed by the supply of foodstuffs, hygiene products and basic household staples.

The families in the country and more than 400 temporary workers who were unable to return to their home countries until June benefited from this action.

Educational programme

"Music and Creativity" and Basket Beat



The programme, which began in 2015, encourages the use of music as a tool for social inclusion, exploring new horizons and bringing artistic participation within everyone's reach.

The methodology is adapted to each group.

In the early months of 2020, the "Music and Creativity" sessions were held with different groups from the Nostra Senyora de Meritxell Private Foundation, such as users of the Day Centre, Xeridell and the Special Education Service.

At the same time, sessions were also held at the DomusVi Salita Residential Centre.

The users of the Claror Workshop in La Seu d'Urgell were also able to enjoy *Music in Claror* sessions.

The Basket Beat sessions were aimed at women who have been victims of gender and/or family violence, students at the Andorran Secondary School in Encamp and second-year students at the Andorran Baccalaureate School, who carried out a participation, action and service (PAS) project. These adolescents ran an inclusive community project with youths from the Community Adolescent Rehabilitation Service (SRCA), part of the Andorran Health Service Mental Health Services.

ONCA WITH YOU

On 13 March, given the COVID-19 health crisis, the ONCA Foundation had to cancel its face-to-face events and launched the ONCA WITH YOU campaign.

The campaign enlisted musicians to participate in artistic actions (short video clips where the artist shares an improvisation or a brief musical piece, presents an instrument or tells a musical anecdote) and educational actions (longer videos offering a music workshop or movement for all audiences). These videos were also sent to all the groups in the social programme.

Ninety artistic and educational short videos were created.

At the same time, a music project based on the joint creation of the song created for the post-lockdown was presented:

ON-SONG - "Inventant un després"

("Inventing an Afterwards").

The song's lyrics were written with the participation of ONCA Foundation followers, who sent in a phrase, verse or idea about what they would like to do once the lockdown was over.

Twenty-seven artists participated, and the Andorran musician Santi Casas was in charge of arranging a ska-reggae musical composition written by the artistic curator of the ONCA Foundation, Albert Gumí. A song with eight verses, a bridge and a coda was created from all the materials received.

The participative song, ON-SONG - "Inventant un després" was chosen as a candidate for the "The best lockdown song", an initiative by the music magazine *Enderrock*. Since 11 May, the video clip has received 3,000 views, making it the most watched video on the ONCA Foundation channel.

SAINT GEORGE'S DAY

To celebrate Saint George's Day, the ONCA Foundation and the Andorran National Cultural Foundation joined forces for the project called *Words of Love*, in which they use their social media channels to post different literary clips, set to music by Andorran artists. The videos were assigned to a duo (an actor and a musician), and they spoke about love under the *leitmotiv*: "If music is love looking for words, imagine what happens when it finds them. Find out this Saint George's Day, with ONCA and ENA".

Seven videos were made, including: Irina Robles delves into Gypsy Ballads, with "Romance de la pena negra" fusing oral and rhythmic traditions with Ivan Caro's beat on the square tambourine. A gift for intimacy.

JONCA IN DANCE

Another proposal was to create an audiovisual project with the name JONCA IN DANCE, featuring the musicians from JONCA and young Andorran dancers. FAMILY WORKSHOP

The action programme was joined by the online family workshop entitled *Pim Pam Repicam* led by the Com Sona? Company with Elena Pereta and Oriol Aguilar. The programme contains two chapters and is recommended for children aged 0 to 3 years old, with live and recorded music focusing on children's songs, games and nursery rhymes. They mix dance and movement, rhythms, games and vocalisations using the Edwin Gordon method.

Additionally, to close the ONCA WITH YOU campaign undertaken during the lockdown and to welcome the summer and the new reality, the ONCA Foundation developed another audiovisual project called WE ARE ALL ONCA, featuring members of the Foundation's social-community musical workshops: "Music and Creativity" and "Music in Claror". This project encompassed 64 artists, including musicians, dancers and users of the Nostra Senyora de Meritxell Private Foundation Day Centre and Occupational Workshop (Xeridell), and users of the Claror Workshop in La Seu d'Urgell. 



The ONCA Foundation is sponsoring the photographic project spearheaded by the nurse Chiqui Novis and designed to "raise awareness of the pandemic and its consequences on people's health without society's due responsibility", describes the Foundation, promoted by the Government and Fundació Crèdit Andorrà. The proposal called *We are not immune* seeks to shed light on the problems posed by COVID and has enlisted the altruistic assistance of artists, athletes, people affected by COVID and staff from cultural organisations, who posed for the photographs.

The photographer, who is a nurse, says that the pandemic has caused a global health crisis "which we can only stop if we're aware of its seriousness and act responsibly", and she highlights that in addition to its health effects, which are the most noticeable, there are also "collateral victims" due to the socioeconomic repercussions of the pandemic. Novis states that it is essential to protect not only healthcare professionals but also "culture, sport, our economy and our creators, business owners and workers", which is why she created the project with images of people from all these spheres to emphasise the importance of combating the virus in order to stop its spread, because it has negative consequences for everyone. Novis stresses that she came up with the idea "because of the power of photography, art and culture, as tools that drive change and social transformation".
